

UBCA Fall Reentry Statement

Union Bible College and Academy is committed to the health and well-being of our students, faculty, and staff. We whole-heartedly believe an on-campus learning experience contributes to that well-being. Therefore, we are taking the following precautions to ensure UBCA can return to the greatest sense of normalcy on our campus for the fall 2020 semester. The UBCA community will:

- Encourage social distancing in all areas of campus
 - Rearrange classrooms where possible
 - Divide student population in common areas such as cafeteria, chapel, gym, etc.
- Enhance personal hygiene efforts
 - Encourage frequent handwashing
 - Enhance accessibility to hand sanitizing stations
 - Educate and promote
 - Minimize shared objects
- Conduct temperature checks
 - Daily for academy students
 - Daily for academy teachers and staff
 - Routinely for college students
 - Routinely for college faculty and staff
- Enhance cleaning and disinfecting measures
 - Wipe down all classroom touch points between usage
 - Disinfect heavily trafficked areas multiple times daily
 - Clean and disinfect all personal areas daily
 - Clean and disinfect dorm common areas daily
- Extend excused absences to any student unable to be in classes due to COVID-19
- Make online learning opportunities available to any student diagnosed with COVID-19
- Provide a controlled quarantine area for any dorm student infected by COVID-19
- Reduce visitation opportunities
 - Limit dorm students to no more than two assistants (parent, sibling, friend) per move in
 - Redirect all academy parents to business office for check in
 - Reorganize on campus events as needed
 - Omit on campus activities as needed
- Require any student, faculty, or staff displaying two or more of the following symptoms to be tested for COVID-19 before returning:
 - Fever and chills (greater than 100.4)
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Muscle or body aches
 - Vomiting or diarrhea
 - New loss of taste or smell
- Require quarantine of 14 days for any student, faculty, or staff testing positive for COVID-19
